For applicable developments in England, BNG is mandatory. The statutory metric measures the baseline and the gain. Significant on-site and off-site habitats must be secured and managed for at least 30 years.

LEGAL REQUIREMENT FOR PLANNING PERMISSION

For most applicable developments in England, Biodiversity Net Gain is a legal planning requirement. Planning permission is subject to a biodiversity gain condition, requiring a minimum 10% increase in biodiversity value. A Biodiversity Gain Plan must be approved by the Local Planning Authority before development begins.

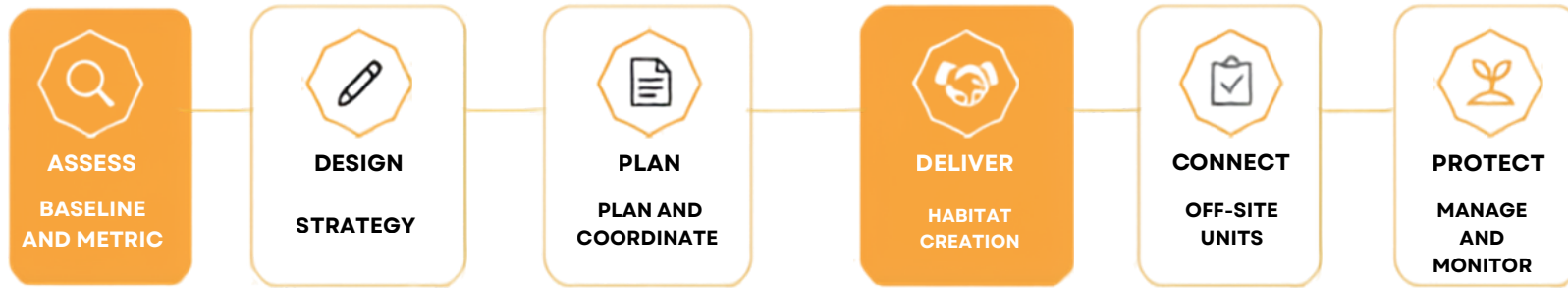
